** The credit quality breakdown depicts the credit quality ratings of the Fund's portfolio securities that are rated by one or both of two major nationally recognized statistical rating organizations ("NRSRO"). The two NRSROs currently utilized are Standard & Poor's (S&P) and Moody's. When a bond is rated by S&P that rating is utilized. If it is not rated by S&P, the Moody's rating is utilized. When a security is rated by neither, it is classified as "Not Rated". For bonds, these credit quality ratings are shown without regard to gradations within a given rating category. For example, securities rated "AA-" or "AA+" have been included in the "AA" rated category.*

Total return assumes reinvestment of dividends. Fund holdings are subject to change.

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Investment Objective

The Fund seeks to provide a high level of current income consistent with preservation of capital.

Investment Strategy

Utilizing a multi-manager approach, the Fund invests in fixed income securities, 80% of which are issued or guaranteed by the U.S. Government or its agents or instrumentalities, and high quality non-convertible of other issuers and money market instruments. The average maturity for the Fund is typically 3 -10 years but may range anywhere from below 5 to over 20 years.

The Fund acts in the traditional role of fixed income, one of capital preservation and income, not capital appreciation.
